# The Structure

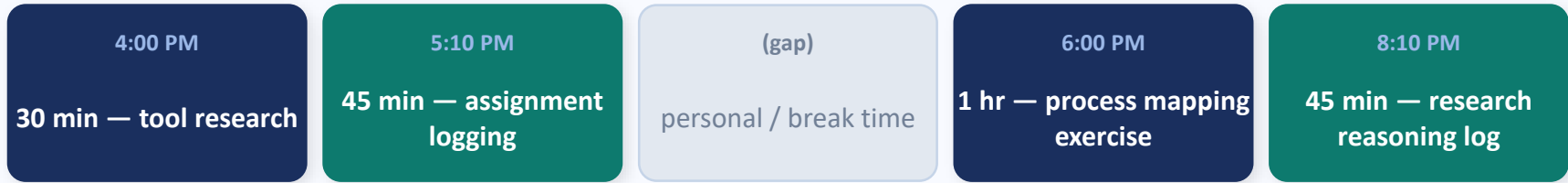
Daily window:

5-hr window · 2 × 30-min breaks = 4 hrs

# How the Hours Actually Happen

Training sessions doesn't need to be 4 hours in a row. It just needs to add up. See below Example:



→ Learn in chunks. Experience a flexible, structured study routine.

→ Log a pause in the tracking tool whenever you're taking a break.

→ Total = 4 hours. How you pace your learning journey is yours to manage.

# The One Non-Negotiable

## Document while you work.

*Not after. Not at end of day. Right now, while it's fresh.*

### ✘ End-of-Session Notes

- Details are fuzzy by evening
- You forget the why behind analytical choices
- Logs read like summaries, not actual research records

### ⚠ During breaks

- Better than End-of-Session
- Still loses context between sessions
- Decision reasoning fades fast

### ✓ As you go

- Every decision captured in real time
- The why is recorded alongside the what
- Docs are accurate and complete training references

# When to Handle vs. When to Ask

1

## Case-Study Block

An assignment requirement isn't working or isn't clear.

2

## Independent Research

Use online resources, docs, re-read the brief.

3

## Still stuck? (Analytical Synthesis)

Form a specific question before reaching out.

4

## Consult Your Mentor

With: what you tried + where you're stuck + what you think the options(proposed paths) are.

✗ "I don't know what to do." → ✓ "I analyzed framework X and Y. The issue is Z. Should I evaluate path A or B?"

# The Flexible Day

## What it is

- ✓ No schedule or required format
- ✓ No calls, no mandatory output
- ✓ Work when you want, on what you want
- ✓ Explore a topic, experiment, rest
- ✓ 1 day per week — Mon, Tue, or Wed

## The Two Rules

### 1 State your plan first

Before you start, write what you plan to do in the training/session tracking tool. Even one line.

### 2 Log stops during the day

Any break of 30+ minutes gets a quick log entry. That's it — no manager notification needed.

On the NEXT fixed session day: add a brief note on what you did. Not a report — just what happened.

# What Day 60 Looks Like

The real test: a future trainee (or intern) can join after you leave and complete the entire track using only your documentation.

## Tool Sandbox

Evaluated, configured and mapped out

## Research Log

Every structural choice documented

## Training Guides

Mock tools — next intern (trainee) can replicate it

## Case-Study Maps

At least 2 simulated workflows mapped

## Analysis Log

What optimization gaps were identified

## Knowledge Transfer

Everything the next batch needs to know
